Reverend Dr. Jerome F. Coleman and Reverend Kimberly Coleman, of the First Baptist Church of Crestmont, established a scholarship fund to support continuing education students. The award was inspired in memory of the late Dr. Donald Clark, an active member of the church, a community leader, educator, advocate for the disenfranchised and a dear friend. He challenged himself and encouraged others to never stop learning. In his honor, this scholarship was established to assist non-traditional students in continuing their formal education. The award is to be used for books and/or other materials needed for school. The funds will be administered by the FBCC Scholarship Ministry and paid directly to the educational institution.

In order to qualify, the student must meet the following criteria:

- The applicant must be 21 years of age or older and a member of FBCC. Applicants must have maintained an active membership for a minimum of one year.
- The applicant must be active in at least one FBCC ministry (i.e. usher, choir member, Sunday School, etc.)
- The applicant must be enrolled in a degree program at an accredited college or university.
- The applicant must complete the attached application in its entirety and return it with the appropriate attachments to the scholarship ministry no later than **Sunday, April 28, 2024.** *
